

**MINUTES  
REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING  
DECEMBER 9, 2019  
BRUCE HIGH SCHOOL IMC**

A regular school meeting of the School Board of the School District of Bruce was held on December 9<sup>th</sup> in the Bruce High School IMC. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by board vice president Steve Golat. Members present were Golat, Kempen, Schweitzer-Hopkins, Robers, and Trott. Anderson and Vohs were absent. Also present were administrators Sturzl, Villiard and Wessman.

Mr. Golat read a statement of proper noticing of the meeting.

A Trott/Schweitzer-Hopkins motion to approve the November 11, 2019 Regular School Board meeting minutes carried.

The financial report with revenues of \$116,030.39 and expenditures of \$567,646.65 was reviewed and filed for audit.

A Trott/Robers motion to approve the vouchers payable carried.

The board discussed the resolution for the delegate assembly that the Bruce School had authored, no action taken.

The board discussed an operational referendum, no action taken.

A Kempen/Trott motion to accept the resignation of kitchen helper, Rhonda Zimmerman carried.

A Schweitzer-Hopkins/Kempen motion to approve hiring Kimberly Quinn for the kitchen helper position carried.

A Schweitzer-Hopkins/Trott motion to approve Kevin Zeeman for Drivers Education carried.

The board reviewed seats up for election in the spring. Those people up for election are Andrew Anderson, Jodi Schweitzer-Hopkins, and Steve Golat, no action taken.

Administrative Reports

Director of Instruction's Report-Carrie Wessman

- Nine high school students took ASVAB testing on November 19<sup>th</sup>. The test measures abilities and helps predict academic and occupational success.
- A Pre-K family singalong was held on November 21<sup>st</sup>.
- ACCESS testing for English as second language learners was held on December 10<sup>th</sup> for eight students to be assessed.
- Pre-K visits Ladysmith Nursing home on December 12<sup>th</sup> to create a Christmas craft together, sing and visit.
- ALICE drill will be held on December 12<sup>th</sup>.

Principal's report-Larry Villiard

- First trimester grade reports were just GREAT. 99.5% of middle school students passed all courses with 95% of high school students passing all courses.
- 7<sup>th</sup> graders participated in Bucky's Classroom at UW Madison. It was a great experience and students provided letters to the board thanking them and highlights of the great experiences that they had.
- The high school and middle school concerts will be on the night of December 9<sup>th</sup>.
- The Children's Annual Holiday Gift Shop will be on December 13<sup>th</sup>. Mary Arts and her staff do a wonderful job. Also this year WEAU TV will be present to broadcast on Channel 13.
- School will dismiss on December 20<sup>th</sup> and resume on January 2<sup>nd</sup> for holiday break.

- Mr. Sturzl met with six other schools involved in the eSucceed Charter School. The school is growing and we have one student participating.
