

Minutes
Regular School Board Meeting
October 10, 2022 6:30 p.m.

A regular meeting of the School Board of the School District of Bruce was held on October 10, 2022 at the Bruce High School IMC. School Board President Roxanne Kemnitz read a statement of proper noticing of the meeting. Members present were Andrew Anderson, Roxanne Kemnitz, Daniel Kempen, Daniel Robers, and Jodi Schweitzer-Hopkins. Members absent were Steve Golat and Andrea Vohs. Also present were Administrators Patrick Sturzl, Carrie Wessman and Brad Cody.

The board meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m. by Board President Roxanne Kemnitz.

An Anderson/Kempen motion to approve the September 12, 2022 Regular Board Meeting minutes carried.

The financial report with revenues of \$727,518.29 and expenditures of \$792,291.81 were reviewed and filed for audit.

A Kempen/Schweitzer-Hopkins motion to approve the vouchers payable carried.

The board discussed high school girls basketball. The plan is to play regular conference schedule with JV games when available.

The board discussed early retirement provision for new employees and tabled it until the November meeting.

A Robers motion to convene to closed session per statute 19.85 (1)(c)(f) carried at 8:14 p.m. by unanimous roll call.


An Anderson/Kempen motion to return to Open Session at 10:11 p.m. carried.
