Bruce Alumni Scholarship

The purpose of the Bruce Alumni Scholarship Fund is to annually grant a one-time scholarship to help graduates of Bruce High School further their post-secondary educations.

It was created in 1995 by the BHS (Bruce High School) Class of 1960 at their 35th class reunion. A classmate from Alaska couldn't attend the reunion but ordered a case of champagne to be served with dinner. Several bottles remained unopened after the meal, so someone suggested auctioning off the remaining champagne and the beautiful floral centerpiece to raise money to establish a scholarship fund. By the end of the evening, over \$800 had been donated!

Since then, numerous contributions have been made by various individuals and other BHS classes. Fundraising initiatives were also added. For example, the BHS Class of 1960 held an auction and raised an additional \$3,300 at their 40th class reunion.

The first Bruce Alumni Scholarship was awarded in 2001. Since then, 98 scholarships have been awarded, ranging from \$300 to \$500 each, totaling over \$38,500!
