Dear Bruce Elementary Families,
Bruce Elementary students receive 30 minutes of Intervention time daily. During Intervention time, each of our students are given an opportunity to work at their academic "just right" level. Students are provided with explicit instruction and frequent opportunities for feedback and practice. We use formal and informal assessments as well as observations to determine how your child might best be served during Intervention time. We place students in Intervention groups and work with them for approximately $6-8$ weeks. Typically students who have the greatest academic needs are placed in the smallest groups. A new intervention time is just beginning.
